

The 6d stamp on this registered cover to the USA would pay the abroad registration fee of 2d, the first ounce foreign fee of 2½d, and the balance of 1½d could pay for a second ounce. The cancellation is that of Georgetown for July 27 1935 and the backstamps include Kingston, Jamaica.
