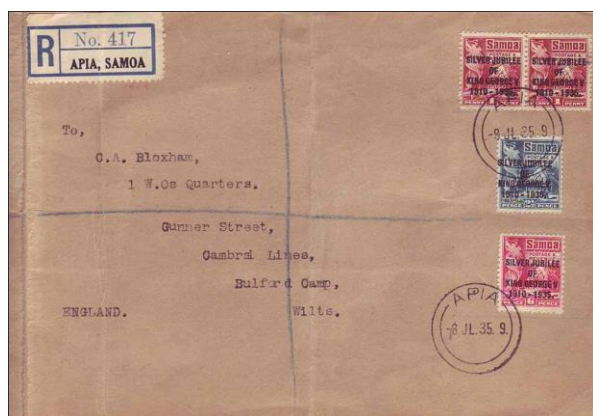

It might have been expected to have been charged at 4d, including 3d registration. Could the charge represent a special forces rate or a rate via Fiji since it bears a Suva backstamp? The dates are: Apia 8 Jl, Suva 20 Jul, Salisbury 20 Au.*
