*This internal cover from Marrakesh to Tangier carries 75c worth of Jubilees. 50c covers the first 20g at the inland rate while the remaining 25c covers a further 30g. The stamps are cancelled with a BPO Marrakesh cds for 8 Jy 35 and the backstamp is of BPO Tangier for 9 Jy 35.*

1F per 10g to France

plus a further 75c if onward transmission to UK is required.
