1/-	Parcel, inland within 30 miles from 2 to 3 lb or, elsewhere inland from 1 to 2 lb
1/3	Parcel, inland within 30 miles from 3 to 5 lb or, elsewhere inland from 2 to 3 lb
1/6	Airmail letter, UK, Canada, Gaza, per ½ oz Parcel, inland within 30 miles from 5 to 8 lb or, elsewhere inland from 3 to 5 lb
1/7	Airmail letter, USA, per ½ oz
1/9	Airmail letter, continental Europe [air to Brindisi, thence by rail], per ½ oz Parcel, inland within 30 miles from 8 to 11 lb
2/-	Parcel, inland over 30 miles from 5 to 8 lb
2/1	Airmail letter, continental Europe [all air service], per ½ oz
2/9	Airmail letter, South Africa, per ½ oz Parcel, inland over 30 miles from 8 to 11 lb
