<b>3/6</b>	Airmail letter, Argentina, Bolivia, Chile, Paraguay, Uruguay, per ½ oz
<b>4/6</b>	Parcel, UK, 7 to 11 lb
<b>4/9</b>	(Parcel, countries served through UK, additional fee to rate from UK, 11 to 22 lb)
<b>5/-</b>	Parcel, Bermuda, B.W.I., British Guiana, British Honduras, 11 to 22 lb, or Canada, 11 to 20 lb
<b>5/3</b>	Parcel, France direct, 11 to 22 lb
<b>7/3</b>	Parcel, UK, 11 to 22 lb
