### Tristan forged bogus overprint – August 2016

Spotted on eBay by John Cooper was this item. It turned out to be a forgery of the Rev. Wilde's Tristan da Cunha overprint. The overprint is much weaker than the original.

Also, the forger would have produced a more convincing effect if he hadn't chosen a booklet stamp in the first place.



### Colour Changeling – June 2016

### Shift Plus – May 2016

Some sellers note a "shifted vignette". While such defects are common, this strip appears to have suffered a slight rotation as well, with the flagstaff of the first column disappearing into the colony's title. The guillotining seems none too exact either.
