### Red Book – October 2016

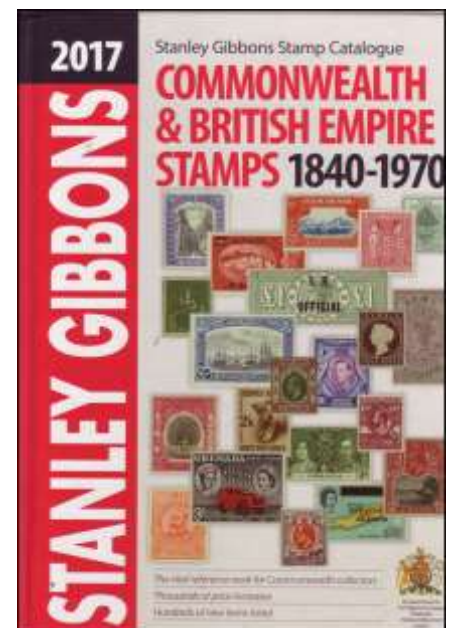
Perhaps due to the lobbying of Bruce Davies, the Gibbons Part One now prices a number of used varieties. Some De La Rue F, G, & H varieties are featured amongst Antigua, Bahamas, Br Guiana, K.U.T., N. Rhodesia & St Lucia. Bradbury B, C, D & E variety used prices show up in Br Honduras, Malta, Seychelles, Swaziland & Trinidad. For Waterlow, K or L varieties are entered for St Vincent or Turks & Caicos.

With Specimens, there are increases for: Falkland's, K.U.T., Nigeria & N. Rhodesia.

In GB, Part One now includes inverted watermark prices.

Any decreases? Well, St Vincent 1d used price is down by £1.

For the whole omnibus set, the mint price is up by £100 to £1500.
