Top of the Colonies

Which British colony is the most popular – in the philatelic sense, that is? At this point, before scrolling down the page, you might want to hazard a guess at the answer for those British possessions that issued the Windsor Castle stamps for the 1935 Silver Jubilee.

Perhaps the album publishers could tell us the answer but what can we learn from the catalogues? We assume a catalogue value reflects the supply as well as the demand but perhaps there is a way of removing the supply variable.

While specimen stamps are not necessarily a "must have" for all collectors, they do have an advantage for our purposes, namely: that the same quantity was produced for each territory. Hence, the catalogue value of specimens should reflect solely the demand level. On this basis, the table below gives the current popularity according to the Gibbons Part 1 for 2015.

In the past eleven years, when this exercise was last carried out, Hong Kong has knocked Falkland Islands into second place. Bermuda and Straits Settlements have overtaken Gibraltar. Gilbert & Ellice went up four places and Malta and K.U.T. down four. Moving over a dozen places are Barbados, (up), Fiji and St. Lucia, (both down).
